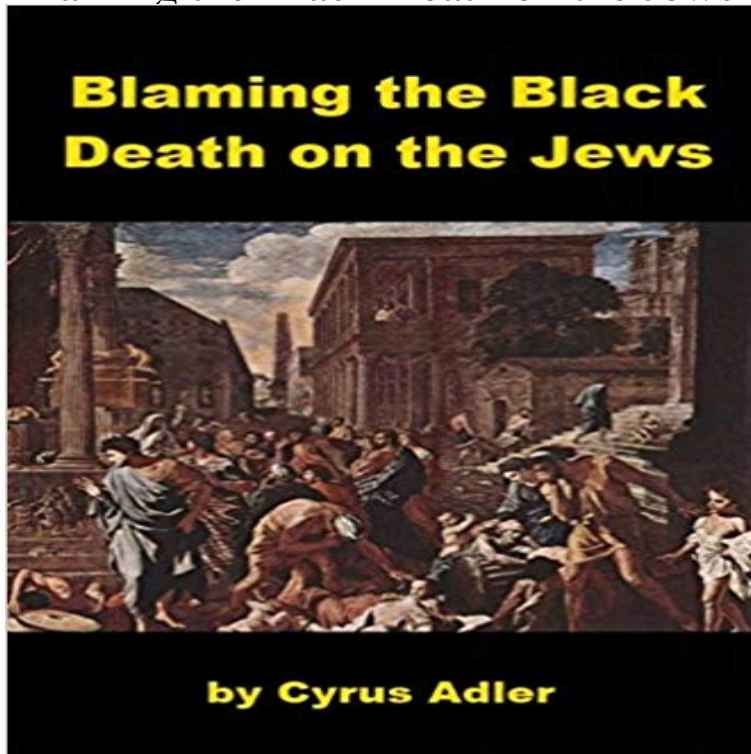


Blaming the Black Death on the Jews
