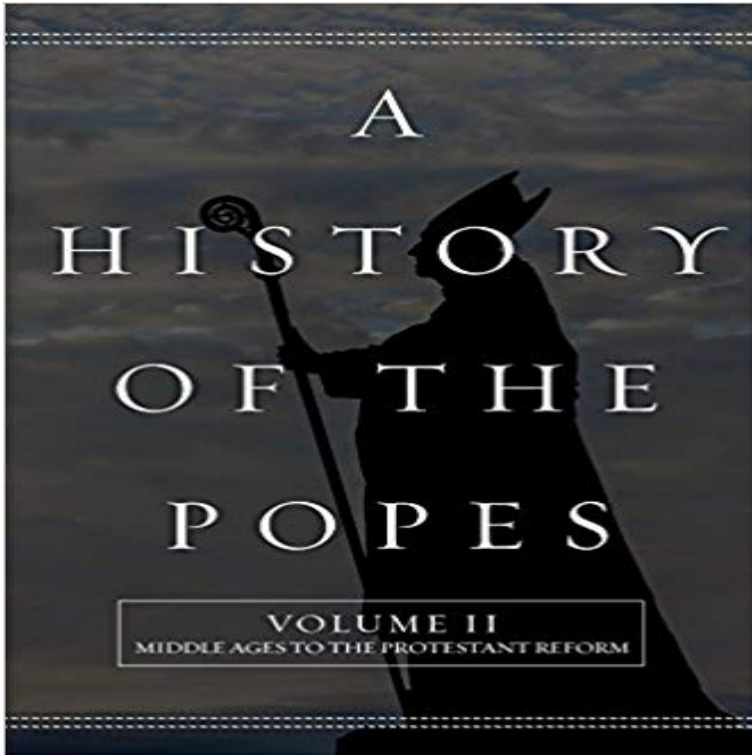


# A History of the Popes: Volume II: Middle Ages to the Protestant Reform
